## Rooms with a View

*West Shore lakefront is light and livable*

With lakefront property at a premium, Tahoe architects and builders are often faced with finding solutions for extreme design challenges. Such was the case for Don Fulda of Ward-Young Architecture & Planning, who was given the task of siting a home on a 50-foot-wide lakefront lot at a 40 degree slope, its neighbor just 15 feet away.

"Don nailed it the first time out," says Meeks Bay homeowner Ann Schweichler. "The design we went with was pretty much his first draft. And the key to the whole con-
